Uxbridge Choral Society is one of the foremost amateur choirs in West London with a growing reputation for exciting repertoire and quality performances.

In September 2017 we were delighted to welcome our new Musical Director Tim Armstrong-Taylor, a graduate of the Guildhall School of music and an experienced and accomplished conductor, singer, composer, writer, teacher and producer. Tim was quick to make his mark with a very varied and well-received carol concert featuring carols by John Rutter and Tim himself, plus many traditional favourites.

This was followed in January by a splendid performance of Mendelssohn's *Elijah*. A member of the audience commented "*This was a really outstanding performance - one which I will never forget. The choir, orchestra and soloists were brilliant; a live performance is so much more than TV or radio.*"

Enjoying a challenge, Tim then presented us with some of the more difficult works in the choral repertoire. We are very proud to have successfully performed Handel's notoriously challenging *Dixit Dominus* and also seven of the wonderful *Sacred Choruses* by Bruckner. Another highlight of the year was a moving performance of Karl Jenkin's *The Armed Man* in which we were joined by a young muezzin from the Hayes Muslim Centre.

### NO FORMAL AUDITION IS REQUIRED

We welcome experienced singers, but also seek to encourage singers who are out of practice, or less experienced. Our aim is to improve the singing technique of all our members. It is a help if you can read music, but we are equally happy if you can learn quickly by ear. Tim will talk to each newcomer, and in accepting new members, he will take account of the need to balance the different voice parts.
